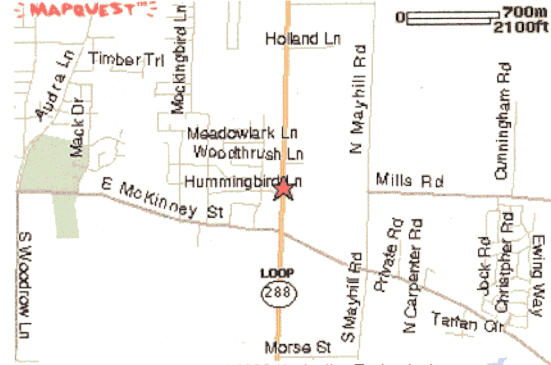

WIC Services

WIC (Women, Infants, & Children) is a special supplemental food program that provides nutrition education and food vouchers for qualifying children, infants, and pregnant or breastfeeding, and post-partum women. Eligibility is limited to those below 185% of federal poverty levels (approximately \$33,485 for a family of four). Please call for an appointment.



Prenatal Services

Prenatal care, nutrition counseling, and education provided for women on the WIC program. Please call for an appointment.

Child Health Clinic

Services provided to well children. The clinic provides education, assessment, development; eligibility required. Please call for an appointment.

Primary Care

Diagnosis and treatment of minor illness and injury. Please call for an appointment; eligibility required.

Dental Services

Dental check-ups and preventive services for children and adults who qualify. Please call for an appointment; eligibility required.

THE FOLLOWING SERVICES ARE NON-QUALIFYING AND ARE OFFERED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

HIV Education

Anonymous and confidential HIV testing and counseling offered to anyone by appointment. There is a \$10 fee for those who can pay.

STD Clinic

Confidential testing, counseling and treatment.

Denton: Monday & Friday 1:00 – 2:30pm
Lewisville: Call for an appointment.

TB Clinic

TB testing daily (except Thursday) during regular hours. Treatment of positive reactors and case contacts by appointment only.

Immunization Clinic

Services available to anyone in Denton County needing immunizations during regular business hours. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18. Fees vary up to a maximum of \$30 per family. No one is refused services if unable to pay. Overseas immunizations range from \$5 - \$125 per shot.

Blood Pressure, Diabetes and Lice Checks

Blood pressure and glucose checks are available for anyone over 18. Lice checks are available to the general public.

These clinics are conducted on a monthly basis. Please call for dates, locations, and times.

Health Education

This department designs health promotion programs, acts as a health information resource, and collaborates with other agencies to improve community health. Health education programs are offered in the following topic areas:

- Asthma & Diabetes Education
- Smoking cessation & prevention
- Generation fit training
- Car Seat & Bicycle helmet safety
- Refusal skills

HEART

The HEALTH EMERGENCY ALERT RESPONSE TEAM identifies and coordinates federal, state and local assets to protect the citizens of Denton County from major public health threats. It plans for public health emergencies, monitors communicable or unusual disease outbreaks, communicates local public health issues, and develops resources to reduce the impact of health threats to Denton County residents.

CHIP

This free or low-cost health insurance program is offered to children ages birth to 18. Eligibility is based on family size and income. Children who qualify will receive a full range of health benefits. Please call for an appointment with the CHIP Outreach Coordinator.



Essential Public Health Services

Essential Service 1: Monitor the health status of individuals in the community to identify community health problems.

Essential Service 2: Diagnose and investigate community health problems and community health hazards.

Essential Service 3: Inform, educate, and empower the community with respect to health issues.

Essential Service 4: Mobilize community partnerships in identifying and solving community health problems.

Essential Service 5: Develop policies and plans that support individual and community efforts to improve health.

Essential Service 6: Enforce laws and rules that protect the public health and ensure safety in accordance with those laws and rules.

Essential Service 7: Link individuals who have a need for community and personal health services to appropriate community and private providers.

Essential Service 8: Ensure a competent workforce for the provision of essential public health services.

Essential Service 9: Research new insights and innovative solutions to community health problems.

Essential Service 10: Evaluate the effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal and population-based health services in a community.
